

BALLARAT BOTANICAL GARDENS FERNERY REDEVELOPMENT



For 131 years, a fernery featuring a uniquely Ballarat structure and an outstanding botanic collection has stood proudly on this site at the Ballarat Botanical Gardens. With continual exposure to all weather, the current structure deteriorated and was closed in 2013. Timber cladding was removed and the structure reopened in early 2015.

A new, enduring fernery development is an exciting project of the City of Ballarat and the Friends of the Ballarat Botanical Gardens.
