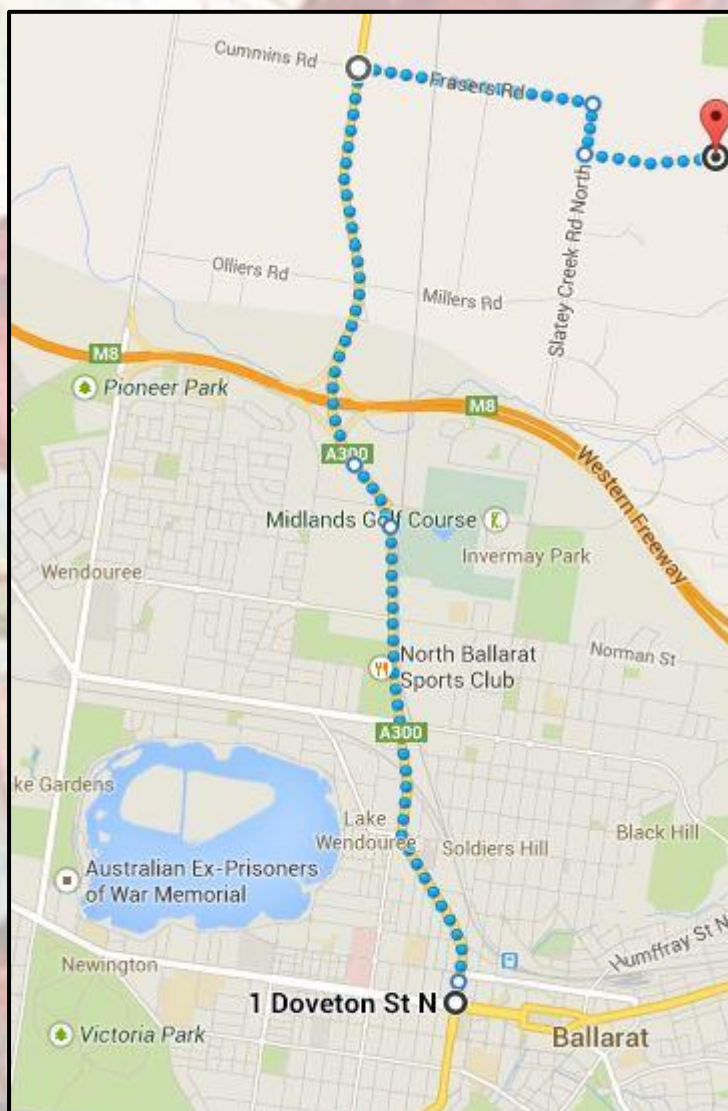


Ballarat GARDENS IN SPRING

From Ballarat head north along Creswick Road and the Midland Highway towards Creswick.

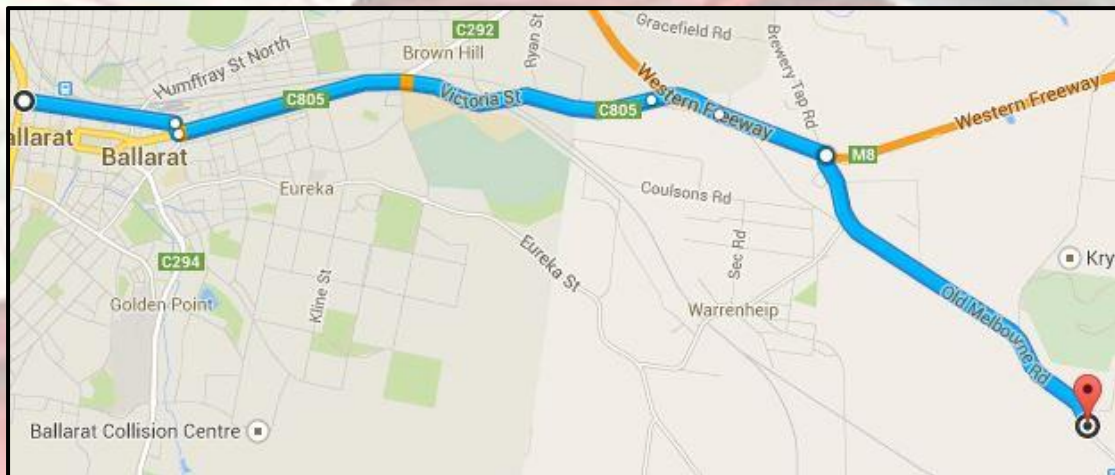
Turn right into Frasers Road at Mount Rowan, then right into Slatey Creek Road and left into Silverwattle Drive, Invermay.

Both of these gardens will be sign-posted and are situated next to each other on the right hand side of a rather narrow road.

From Ballarat travel east along Victoria Street and the Western Highway towards Melbourne.

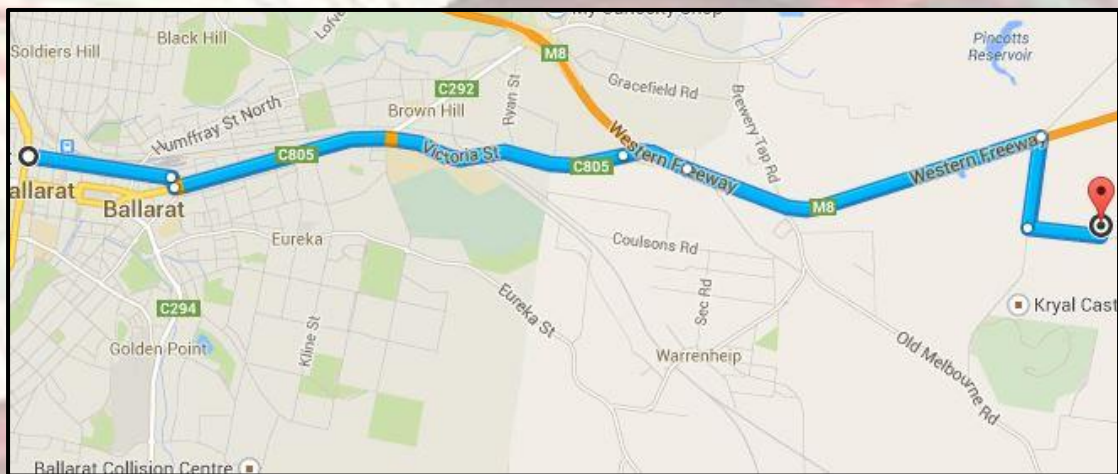
At the bottom of Woodman’s Hill turn right towards Warrenheip and Dunnstown.

Travel along the Old Melbourne Road towards Dunnstown for 3 kilometres. The Olive Branch is on right on a small service road and will be well sign-posted.

To reach Redbank Farm continue along the Old Melbourne Road to the Dunnstown roundabout, continue across the roundabout and head towards Yendon for 1 kilometre. Redbank Farm is on the left hand side of Dunnstown-Yendon Road.

From Ballarat head east out on Victoria Street and the Western Highway towards Melbourne.
Turn right at the Koyal Castle turnoff at Leigh Creek.
Then turn first left into Mahers Road. The Manna Garden is at the top of the hill.
